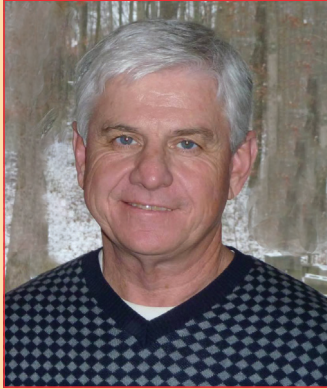


SPECIAL RECOGNITION
